## Origin declaration according to the transitional rules of origin of the pan-Euro-Mediterranean (PEM) area and the PEM Convention

Please note:

If <u>the new transitional rules of the PEM area that entered in force on 1 September 2021</u> have been used when determining the origin of the goods, you should enter the text "according to the transitional rules of origin" after "<sup>(2)</sup> preferential origin" as shown below. If you leave out this text, the rules of the current PEM Convention will be applied to the goods.

*The exporter of the products covered by this document (customs authorization No* ......<sup>(1)</sup>) declares that, except where otherwise clearly indicated, these products are of......<sup>(2)</sup> preferential origin (\*according to the transitional rules of origin).

\*If the new transitional rules of origin of the PEM area have been applied in determining the origin of the product, the exporter must indicate this at the end of the origin declaration as shown above. If the rules of origin of the PEM Convention have been applied in determining the origin, this text is left out.

\*If in determining the origin of the products being exported to the CEFTA countries, Decision 3/2015 of the CEFTA Joint Committee has been applied, you must indicate this at the end of the declaration of origin by placing the text "(\*according to the Decision 3 /2015 of the CEFTA)".

<sup>1</sup> When the origin declaration is made out by an approved exporter, the authorisation number of the approved exporter must be entered in this space. When the origin declaration is not made out by an approved exporter, the words in brackets shall be omitted or the space left blank.

<sup>3</sup> These indications may be omitted if the information is contained on the document itself.

<sup>4</sup> In cases where the exporters is not required to sign, the exemption of signature also implies the exemption of the name of the signatory.
